


1980's Shades

Supplies

- Cardstock
- Scissors or an x-acto knife
- Paint and a brush
- Glue or tape
- 80's shades template
- Colored transparency sheets
- Washi or duct tape
- Cut shapes or other embellishments
- glitter



Instructions

1. Print the 80's shades template on cardstock and cut out all pieces for glasses with scissors or an x-acto knife. (Get an adult to help)
2. Paint with some radical colors, maybe even patterns! Paint the glasses one color or choose a couple. Paint the sides a different color, or create a pattern! Use duct/washi tape or patterned paper to cover the glasses. Neon, pastels, animal prints, metallic, and geometric shapes were ALL super hot in the eighties.
3. Add transparent "lenses." This is the perfect time to add a super cool colored "lens" to the glasses. Cut out a strip of transparency, trim to fit the glasses and glue to the back .
4. Assemble glasses with glue. Measure to be sure the glasses are going to be the right size to fit.
