

Pre-historic Cave Paintings

Supplies

- bunch of shredded paper
- art paste
- hot water
- paperclip
- cave drawing template
- black and brown sharpie
- vine charcoal (messy)
- newspaper



Instructions

1. To make the cave wall pieces, gather bags of shredded paper and pour some hot water into the bag to soften the paper. Seal the moist paper shreds in the bag and wait 24 hours.
2. The next day, mix up a couple of batches of art paste (and pour a bunch into the bags of softened recycled paper. Squish the "dog drool" into the gloppy paper. Art Paste is an easy to use powder that mixes with water to form a glue paste, ideal for paper mâché and other craft projects.
3. Lay down newspaper, knead the lump, breaking down the paper so it becomes a textural claylike substance. Pat the lump into a slab of rock wall. Before putting it away to dry fully, insert a paper clip into the top to serve as a hanger.
4. With sharpie or vine charcoal, draw a story use the cave drawing template.
